Upon completion, this pavilion will serve as the permanent home for the Downtown Orangeburg Farmers' Market and will additionally house other DORA & community events.

The Downtown Farmers' Market is a notable success and strong addition to Downtown Orangeburg. The market is entering its fifth year and is currently home to over twelve local farmers, artisans and non-profits. This weekly seasonal event attracts over 5,000 residents to shop downtown every year.

DORA's events and activities serve the mission of building a strong economic base for Downtown Orangeburg and our community at large, now and into the future.
